Family Rosary Group

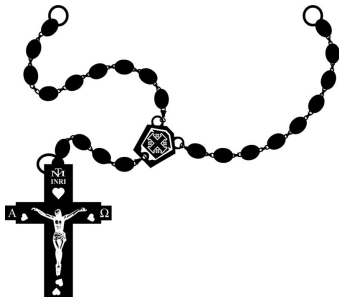
