New for next year, if your family income is 250% or less of the national poverty level you may qualify for a scholarship that covers full tuition. 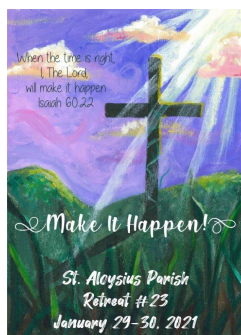


COVID-19 Travel Advisory:

The State of Ohio currently recommends quarantine for anyone returning to Ohio from the states listed below. Passing through one of these states qualifies for quarantine if there was interaction with individuals in that state. St. Aloysius is requiring that any student that fits this criteria quarantine for 14 days upon return. Based on a 7-day rolling average of positivity rates of January 6th, the affected states are: **Idaho, Alabama, Iowa, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, Kansas, Tennessee, Arkansas, Utah, Mississippi, Oklahoma, Georgia, Texas, Kentucky, Missouri, South Carolina, Arizona and Nevada.** Ohio has also reached the 15% positivity rate so please stay home as much as possible.

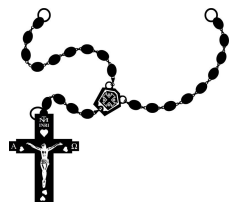
