- **Online Registration is DUE TOMORROW.** Please send in registration and classroom materials fees and complete the online eForms in Option C to reserve your child's spot for the 21-22 school year. We also need scholarship paperwork turned in if you plan to apply or reapply. - **It is more important than ever to register early this year.** Since we don't know for sure what next year will look like with spacing and class sizes, we want to be sure your child has their spot guaranteed. Registration MUST be done by March 5th because we will be opening registration to the public soon after.

### From the Nurse:

- If any students are planning to travel to another state make sure to check if you will need to quarantine for 14 days when you return. Day one of the quarantine starts the day after you return.
- All international travel requires a quarantine for 14 days when you return, even if a COVID test is administered. Let me know if you have any other questions.
- The CDC and WCHD have not changed any of the guidelines for students that have been exposed outside of the classroom. A 14 day quarantine is still required after the exposure. Day one is the day after the exposure. If anything changes, I will let you know.
- Please complete the attached 7th grade immunization form for students going into 7th grade. If anyone has any questions about Kindergarten or 7th grade immunizations, please let me know. School fax: 419-352-4738

### COVID-19 Travel Advisory:

The State of Ohio currently recommends quarantine for anyone returning to Ohio from the states listed below or following international travel. Passing through one of these states qualifies for quarantine if there was interaction with individuals in that state. St. Aloysius is requiring that any student that fits this criteria quarantine for 14 days upon return. Based on a 7-day rolling average of positivity rates of March 3rd, the affected states are: **Idaho, South Dakota, Iowa, Alabama, and Kansas.**
