



Grant or Scholarship Opportunities

St. Aloysius charges the exact amount to educate a student. All families have different scholarship opportunities open to them. Please apply for the scholarship/grant that applies to your family. The criteria for each are listed below.

Parishioner Grant: (\$2000)

- + The family has at least one family member in the home who is Catholic and is registered with St. Aloysius Parish or a parish in the diocese that does not have a school.
- + Through the use of time, talent and treasure the family helps support their parish.
- + The family attends Mass.

Multi-student Grant: (amount varies)

- + Families with multiple children in school may apply for the multi-student grant, value increases for each additional child attending St. Aloysius. See application for detail.

Ed Choice Expansion Scholarship: (\$4650)

- + This is a state of Ohio scholarship open to families whose total household income is 250% of the poverty line. Students must be entering grades KR-8. If a family believes they may qualify, please refer to the application included for details.

Ed Choice Traditional Scholarship: (\$4650)

- + While there are no schools on the failing list for 21-22, those who currently have the scholarship will be able to keep it.

Jon Peterson Scholarship: (amount varies)

- + This is a state of Ohio scholarship open to students on an IEP. This scholarship will pay for services for the students and in some cases will pay for tuition. Please contact the school office for details. If your child is on an IEP, please contact the school office.

Northwest Ohio Scholarship Fund: (amount varies)

- + This is an independent scholarship opportunity. The application deadline is April 30, 2021. Applicants must meet financial requirements and be drawn through a lottery to be awarded. EdChoice Expansion Scholarship Checklist

The EdChoice Expansion scholarship is income based. It is open to all students who qualify entering Kindergarten through grade 8 for the 2021-2022 school year. If your family qualifies, your student's tuition cost will be covered.

*****Income eligibility guidelines have changed for the 21-22 school year. The gross annual income has changed from 200% to 250% of the poverty level, so those who did not qualify in the past may now qualify.*****

Please use the checklist below for gathering all documents needed for an initial application. If you are renewing your scholarship, a packet will be sent to you directly from the State of Ohio. Contact the school office for detailed information, 419.352.8614. A Spanish version is available in the office or online.

- Check the Income Eligibility Requirements attached to see if your household size and income qualifies your family for the scholarship.

If you qualify, return the following items to the school office:

- Complete your child's registration:
 - eForms in Option C for returning families **OR**
 - paper registration packet (for new families)
- Complete the EdChoice Request form
- Provide a copy of the student's birth certificate (if not on file)
- Provide a copy of a current utility bill with BOTH the SERVICE and BILLING address. If the bill is not in the parents' name, a letter from the property owner is required. (A cell phone bill is not an accepted proof of residence.)

Return the following items to the State of Ohio:

- Complete the Income Verification form.
- Provide a copy of W2's, 1040, or current check stubs as listed on the Income Verification form.

Further Instruction

- All application paperwork should be turned into the school office. If you want the school office to mail all documents, we are happy to do so.
- If you wish to mail the income information yourself, it must include:
 - Income verification form
 - Proof of income: W2's, 1040, or check stubs to the address listed at the top of the Income Verification Form.

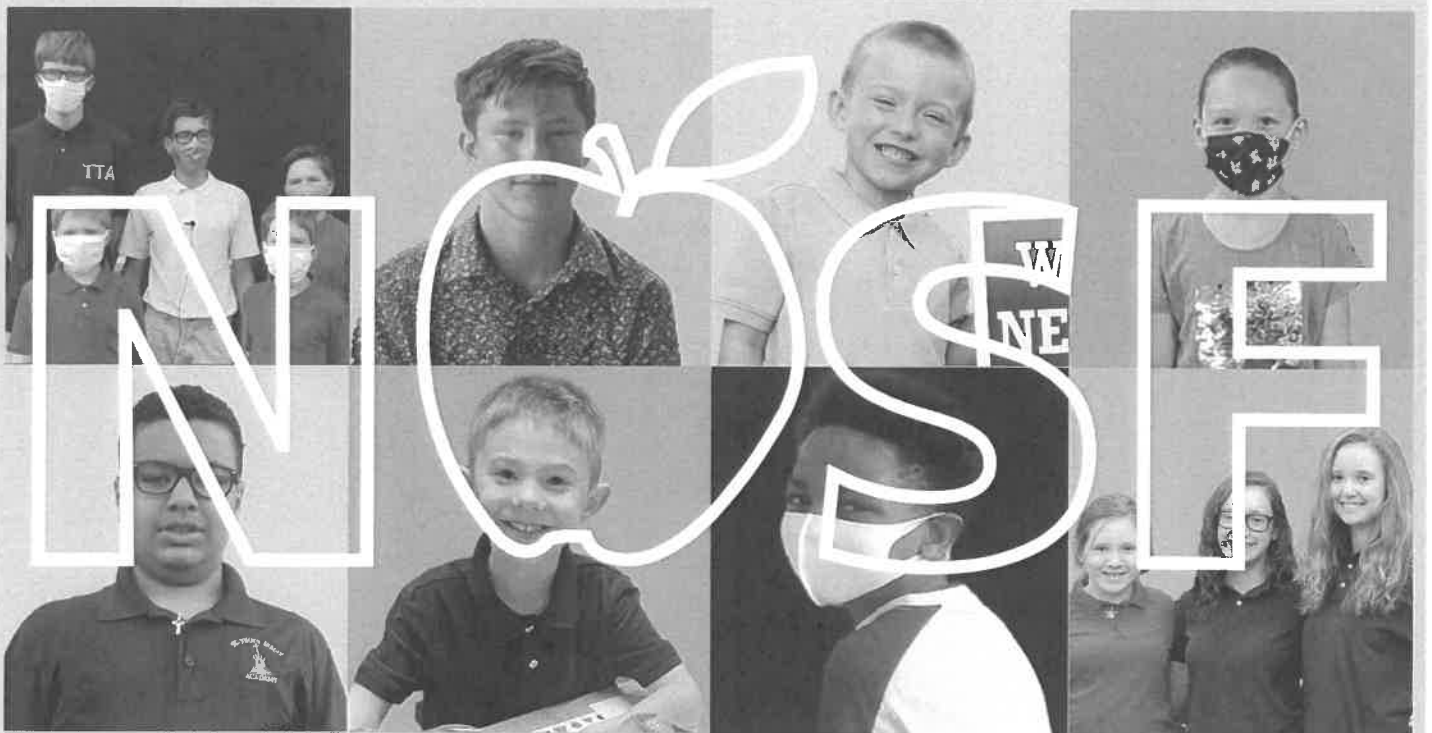
All families applying for an EdChoice-Expansion scholarship must have their income verified by the EdChoice Office. When applying for an EdChoice-Expansion scholarship **for the first time**, the total household income must be at or below 250% of the federal poverty guidelines (see chart above). All new EdChoice-Expansion applicants must have a household income of 250% or lower to be awarded a scholarship.

Families **renewing their child's EdChoice-Expansion Scholarship for the next school year** will be awarded an amount based on where their family's household income falls on the federal poverty guidelines:

- **0% - 250%** = full scholarship = maximum award of \$4,650 K-8, \$6,000 9-12
- **251% - 300%** = 75% of the scholarship = maximum award of \$3487.50 K-8, \$4,500 9-12
- **301% - 400%** = 50% of the scholarship = maximum award of \$2,325 K-8, \$3,000 9-12
- **Over 400%** = cannot renew the scholarship

Expansion families with a household income of 250% or lower qualify for low income status. This means that the private school cannot charge these families for any tuition that is not covered by the scholarship.

Expansion families with a household income of 251% or higher are responsible for paying any tuition difference not covered by the scholarship.



SCHOLARSHIPS FOR EDUCATIONAL CHOICES

You have a choice for your child's education with a need-based scholarship from the Northwest Ohio Scholarship Fund

- Scholarships are available up to \$2,000 for private school tuition and \$750 for homeschool expenses.
- To qualify your family must meet the annual income requirements and reside in one of 19 Northwest Ohio counties including Allen, Crawford, Defiance, Erie, Fulton, Hancock, Henry, Huron, Lucas, Ottawa, Paulding, Putnam, Richland, Sandusky, Seneca, Van Wert, Williams, Wood or Wyandot counties.

Getting Started on the Northwest Ohio Scholarship Fund Application Process

Do you qualify for an NOSF scholarship?

There are requirements that must be met to qualify for tuition assistance:

- Must be a resident in *Allen, Crawford, Defiance, Erie, Fulton, Hancock, Henry, Huron, Lucas, Ottawa, Paulding, Putnam, Richland, Sandusky, Seneca, Van Wert, Williams, Wood or Wyandot Counties*
- Children must be entering into the **K-8 grade** for the 2021-2022 school year
- Income and household size must meet requirements (see below)

Income Eligibility for the 2021-2022 School Year

Find your income on this chart, and note the percentage of tuition for which you qualify, according to your household size (includes children and adults in house). The maximum scholarship amount is \$2,000 for private school tuition and \$750 for homeschool expenses per year. Please remember that each family must pay at least \$500 towards tuition.
