From the Principal:

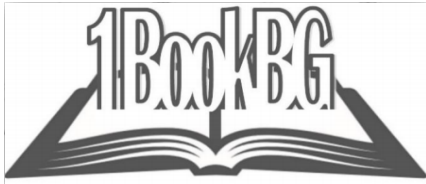
